This information is to encourage and help you become informed and involved in your child's education. You are invited to participate in the planning, review and implementation of our WIN (What I Need) program.

We want you to understand why your child receives additional services and the goals being set for them.

- Communication begins in the fall when students are identified for services.
- WIN teachers and classroom teachers may meet with you during parent/teacher conferences to share data and join in on the conversation about your child's progress.
- Reading materials will be sent home for the purpose of student practice and mastery.
- WIN teachers may communicate more frequently with you than just district scheduled conferences to share your child's progress.

We will provide you with materials to help successfully work with your child.

- Books/reading activities are sent home regularly for you to review with your child. Math activities
 will be shared periodically.
- Your child's individual WIN teacher or classroom teacher will provide additional resources specific to your child's needs as necessary.

We will provide multiple opportunities to learn about the school-wide WIN/Title I program.

- There will be school wide Family Title I events and activities throughout the year (online this
 year) where WIN teachers and classroom teachers will have information available to you
 describing the WIN/Title I program.
- You are able to access Title I information at the district and on the Birch Lake website.

We will help you become involved in your child's education by providing opportunities to engage in his/her education.

- The Title I Family-School Compact stresses that your child's academic success needs the support of both home and school.
- You are invited to participate in (online) family events and meetings which allow the opportunity to share, provide input and connect with other families throughout the year.
- Translators will be accommodated with notice.

We will provide opportunities for feedback on the WIN/Title I school-wide program.

- An open house for the WIN program will be held during parent/teacher conferences (online this year)
